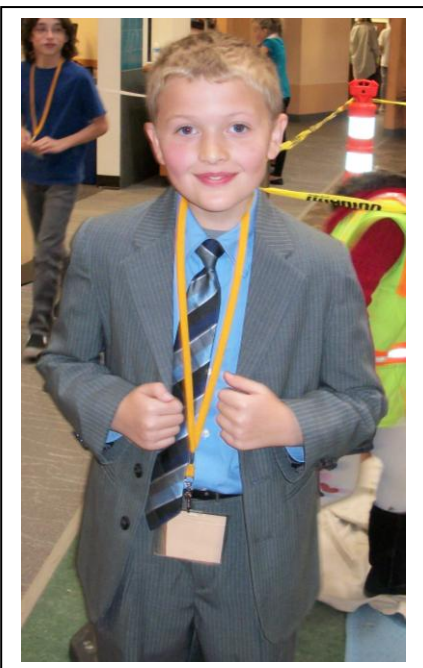
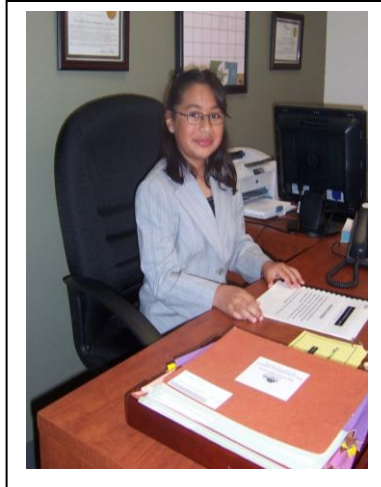




2015 Junior Achievement (JA) BizTown Program

Elementary school students are not old enough to drive, work or vote. But that doesn't stop them from operating banks, managing businesses, writing checks, paying taxes and earning a profit at the McGrath Family JA BizTown!

JA BizTown is a 10,000 sq. foot mini-city in which kids discover how the "real world" works. On the field trip day to the JA BizTown San Diego facility, students become JA BizTown "citizens" working in one of 22 businesses, and having the opportunity to be both a producer and consumer.

In preparation for their visit to The McGrath Family JA BizTown™, students will be learning about the free enterprise system through active participation in weekly activities including: "Teller Time", "Lemonade Stand", Interview Triads, Biztown "Jeopardy", and "Banking Bingo", to name a few. After being assigned their Biztown job, students will work in their business teams to write ads, create budgets, apply for a bank loan, and develop their marketing strategies.

After the curriculum has been taught, students go on an all-day fieldtrip to The McGrath Family JA BizTown in San Diego and become "grown-ups" for one day! BizTown™ is a 10,000 square foot mini-city, with 22 life-size businesses, designed to reflect San Diego in the businesses, landscape, and architecture

At BizTown, students are in charge! They will run their business, take breaks, visit the bank, pay bills, vote, and become a consumer in the city.

Students leave The McGrath Family JA BizTown feeling personally successful. They also leave with a greater understanding of the value of a dollar, the importance of teamwork, and how to be a contributing citizen in the community.

The time spent at The McGrath Family JA BizTown is only one day, but impact that this experiential learning program has will last a lifetime!
